Area of Consideration

Open to current members of the Puerto Rico Army National Guard in the grade of PVT2/E2 to SGT/E5. **Must hold a GRANTED Security Clearance. All MOS's may apply.**

Eligibility Criteria

REQUIRED ASVAB SCORE IN ST -95. Proof of eligibility must be attached with the application.

Application Procedures

Qualified applicants must submit applications as described below to the address in the upper left hand corner of this announcement. Applications must be received by COB on the closing date. **Faxed or incomplete applications will not be accepted or considered.**

1. **NGB 34-1** must be complete with original signature.
2. **PHYSICAL:** Individual Medical Readiness Record (MEDPROS) with date of last PHA within 12 months.
 - If your last PHA is over 12 months old at time of hire a new PHA will be required prior to hire date.
 - Must have **HIV** less than 24 months old at time of application (If it is older than 24 months you are required to have new test results prior to hire date).
3. **DA Photograph in ASU military uniform**, three-quarter or full length, taken within the last 12 months.

4. Photocopy of last 5 **NCOERs (If applicable)**.
5. Certified true copy of **ERB, each sheet** must be certified with **original signature** of unit administrator or State MILPO.

7. Copy of latest **APFT Scorecard (DA 705)** (must be less than 12 months old). Profiles must be attached if applicable.
8. Must have a **DA 5500 (Male) or 5501-R (Female)** attach if body fat content test required.
9. **NGB 23**, NGB 23b (RPAS Statement), retirement record.
10. Copy of all **DD214's / NGB 22's** showing all prior service.
11. Copy of current **Driver's License**.
12. Score of 75 or above on the American Language Course Placement Test (ALCPT) within 12 months.
13. A rating of 2+/2+ on the Communication Skills Interview (CSI) within 12 months.
14. Applicants must comply with requirements established in the American Language Course Placement Test (ALCPT) directives. Security Clearance

A Secret Security Clearance must be attained within 12 months from the AGR hire date. If a Security Clearance cannot be attained you will be considered for removal from the AGR program as per NGR (AR) 600-5.

Minimum Eligibility Criteria

Applicants must not be candidates for an elective office, hold a civil office (full-time or part-time), or be engaged in partisan political activities as defined in AR 600-20. Individuals who voluntarily resign the AGR Program in lieu of adverse personnel actions are not eligible to reenter the program. Individuals who have separated from the military service for cause, unsuitability, or unfitness for military service (other than temporary medical disability) are ineligible for reenter/enter in the program. Individuals not selected for continuation in the AGR Program who has been involuntarily removed from the program as a result of maximum years of service, qualitative retention, cause, or selective retention board actions are ineligible. Must meet requirements as stated in the "Areas of Consideration". Must not be ineligible for AGR service under AR 135-18. Additional eligibility requirements for officer/warrant officers, enlisted personnel, are established in para 2-2, 2-3, and 2-24 NGR 600-5 respectively. Must meet medical standards prescribed by AR 40-501 chapter 3. Must not be under a current suspension of favorable personnel actions. Applicants must not be entitled to receive Federal military retired or retainer pay or Federal civil service annuities and not be eligible for immediate Federal Civil Service annuities.

Individuals voluntarily separated from the AGR Program for one or more days are not eligible to reenter the program for 1 year from the date of separation.

Minimum Prerequisites

- Candidates will be screened IAW DA Pam 40-8/NGR 500-3 and given Pulmonary Function tests (PFT) prior to accession.
- A signed counseling statement to attest to the agreement of the II applicable requirements per NGR 500-3 will be signed before interview process.
- Must possess or be able to obtain Government Travel Card.
- The assignments require extensive travel (2 or more weeks a month) for training and response operations.
- Must have a positive attitude and willing to work with team mates.
- Member will be required heavy lifting during operations.
- Requirement to receive Anthrax/Small Pox vaccines should the applicant be selected.
- Reside within one (1) hour commute from duty location.
- Candidate will be submitted to a health professional and/or psychiatrist counselor for hiring process.
- Continue to list a **passing OSHA Physical** as requirement for employment.
- CST members are required to maintain **24/7/365 availability to respond** to a no-notice alert IAW state and national response requirements.
- Fire Fighting, Incident Command System, Emergency Medical, and Hazardous Material response is a plus and also, Law enforcement experience.
- Computer skills.
- Normal color vision is required and non-waiver able.

Specialized Requirements (KSA's)

Ability to communicate in English and Spanish in a clear and concise manner, both orally and in writing. Knowledge of rules, regulations, policies and procedures related to supply, administration, training, and operations programs. Need to complete the following courses; NBC Defense Course and Field Management of Chemical Casualties Course (Desired). **Must pass the Civil Support Skill Course (CSSC).**

Responsible to perform the duties of NBC Team Chief in the event the NBC Team Chief is not available during a Weapons of Mass Destruction (WMD) incident. Participates in the state of the art detection and sample collection technology for real world response to WMD or Chemical, Biological, Nuclear, and High Yield Explosives (CBRNE) events in all weather and in any situation (air, sea, land) in support of the local incident Commander through the established chain of command. Required to use personal protective equipment (PPE) up to and including Level A fully encapsulating suits. Expected to be proficient in Combat Life Saver, Haz Mat response, NBC antidote administration, safe patient extraction, and crime scene/evidence preservation techniques. Prepares and monitors WMD sampling chain of custody (sample transfer) procedures. Follows civilian and military references and checklist when responding to incidents utilizing the appropriate respiratory protective and PPE. Utilizes the established checklist and code words in reporting the detection, identification and sample collection actions in the Hot Zone/contaminated area using state of the art communications equipment and sampling equipment. Performs Other Duties as assigned.
