Area of Consideration

All Warrant Officers of the Puerto Rico Army National Guard in the grade of WO1 to CW2, **MOS 155E**. Applications that do not comply with the **MOS 155E** requirement will not be considered.

Application Procedures

Qualified applicants must submit applications as described below to the address in the upper left hand corner of this announcement. Applications must be received by COB on the closing date. **Faxed or incomplete applications will not be accepted or considered.**

1. **NGB 34-1** must be complete with original signature.
2. **PHYSICAL:** Individual Medical Readiness Record (MEDPROS) with date of last PHA within 12 months.
 - Must have **HIV** less than 24 months old at time of application.
 - Soldier must be able to pass a Medical Physical. If not, the next person on the Order of Merit List (OML) will be selected.
 - Applicant must have a current Flying Duty Medical Examination within 12 months and a current DD Form 2992, DA Form 4186 Medical Recommendation for Flying Duty is acceptable within 12 months.
3. **DA Photograph in ASU military uniform**, three-quarter or full length, taken within the last 12 months.

4. Photocopy of last 3 **OERs (If applicable)**.
5. Certified true copy of **ORB**, certified with **original signature** of unit administrator or State MILPO.
6. Copy of last **APFT Scorecard (DA Form 705)** (APFT must be less than 12 months old). Profiles must be attached if applicable.
7. Must have a **DA Form 5500 (Male) or 5501-R (Female)** attach if body fat content test required.
8. **NGB Form 23**, NGB Form 23b (RPAM Statement), retirement record.
9. Copy of all **DD Form 214's / NGB Form 22's** showing all prior service.
10. Copy of current **Driver's License**.
11. Soldier must not have a temporary profile.
12. Certified true copy of the latest DA Form 759 Individual Flight Record and Flight Certificate-Army.
13. Certified true copy of a CAFRS-12 printout within 30 days of application.

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Qualification Requirements

Applicant must hold an aeronautical designation as Army Aviator with a current NGB Aviation Service order. Possess a minimum of 36 months rated aviation service as Army Aviator. Must be qualified in one of the following aircraft: C-12, KA300, KA350. (Preferably qualified in the C-12U Huron). Must possess 1000 hours total time of which 500 hours must be logged in a US Army or US Army contract fixed wing aircraft. Preferably Pilot in Command (PIC) designation in aircraft mission, design, type and series. If not PIC designated must be able to achieved a PIC designation within 3 months from hiring. Applicant must be fully qualified to attend FWMEIPC within 12 months of hiring date.

Minimum Eligibility Criteria

Applicants must not be candidates for an elective office, hold a civil office (full-time or part-time), or be engaged in partisan political activities as defined in AR 600-20. Individuals who voluntarily resign the AGR Program in lieu of adverse personnel actions are not eligible to reenter the program. Individuals who have separated from the military service for cause, unsuitability, or unfitness for military service (other than temporary medical disability) are ineligible for reenter/enter in the program. Individuals not selected for continuation in the AGR Program who has been involuntarily removed from the program as a result of maximum years of service, qualitative retention, cause, or selective retention board actions are ineligible. Must meet all requirements as stated in the "Areas of Consideration". Must not be ineligible for AGR service under AR 135-18. Additional eligibility requirements for officer/warrant officers, enlisted personnel, are established in para 2-2, 2-3, and 2-24 NGR 600-5 respectively. Must meet medical standards prescribed by AR 40-501 chapter 3. Must not be under a current suspension of favorable personnel actions. Applicants must not be entitled to receive Federal military retired or retainer pay or Federal civil service annuities and not be eligible for immediate Federal Civil Service annuities.

Individuals voluntarily separated from the AGR Program for one or more days are not eligible to reenter the program for 1 year from the date of separation.
